

RESORT VILLAGE OF GRANDVIEW BEACH

BYLAW 04 – 13

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE CERTAIN EXPENDITURES

The Council of the Resort Village of Grandview Beach, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts the following:

1. This bylaw shall be known as the "Expenditure Authorization Bylaw"
2. Definitions:
For the purpose of this bylaw, the following words shall have the following meaning:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality, and;
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Resort Village of Grandview Beach.
3. The administrator, together with another person designated by council to sign cheques on its behalf, is hereby authorized to pay certain accounts either by cheque or by electronic transfer in a timely fashion, namely:
 - a) Wages and salaries payable to municipal employees;
 - b) Employee payroll deductions, including municipal contributions;
 - c) Telephone, heat, power, waste services;
 - d) Supply purchases so as to prevent interest charges accruing for late payment on account; and.
 - e) Collections on behalf of other taxing authorities.
4. The administrator shall advise council at its next regular meeting of the particulars of transactions undertaken in accordance with Section 3 of this bylaw, including but not limited to:
 - a) The transaction date;
 - b) The amount paid; and,
 - c) The payee.
5. The bylaw comes into force and takes effect when adopted by Council.
