The 2023 mill rate is 1.65% which remains the same as last year. The 15% discount is available until **June 30<sup>th</sup>**. Tax notices have been sent out. For your convenience, both postdated cheques and monthly installment payments are acceptable.

## GARBAGE BINS

Please use the Loraas bins at the transfer station for regular household waste. *Mattresses, TVs, construction material are **not** allowed.* (Violators will be invoiced for any cleanup that is required.) Please break down cardboard boxes when placing them in the bins. Or better yet, if at all possible, take your cardboard to a public recycling depot

## PERMITS REQUIRED

FOR DEVELOPMENT/BUILDING/DEMO

Permits are required for any development. Please contact the office for additional details and application forms. Demolition permits are required for removal of all or a portion or any structure.

In addition to any permit required by the resort village, you may require an aquatic habitat protection permit if you are doing any work at or near the shoreline. The Water Security Agency can provide that information at 306-787-1319. Any unlawful shoreland work observed may be reported anonymously by calling 1-800-667-7561.

Please remember that **no** motorized vehicles are allowed in the park including all golf carts and ATV's.

**Please remember that the MAXIMUM speed limit in the Village is 30 km/hr.**

## ***BEACH & BOATING***



Pets are *NOT PERMITTED* on the beach

Boats are prohibited in the swimming area and fishing is not permitted on the swimming dock.

## HYGIENIC WATER USE SYSTEM

This Notice applies to all residents and users of the Resort Village of Grandview Beach Waterworks and is issued under section 36 (1) of *The Environmental Management and Protection Act, 2010*.

This **Do Not Drink** Notice is issued due to the waterworks system being classified as a "Hygienic Water Use System" and we cannot ensure the safety of the water in the distribution system. The Water Security Agency and Resort Village of Grandview Beach are reminding all consumers to **NOT USE THE TAP WATER FOR:**

- **Drinking or ingesting in any manner;**
- **Brushing teeth or soaking false teeth;**
- **Dishwashing, unless sanitized in another fashion;**
- **Washing fruits and vegetables;**
- **Cooking;**
- **Food or drink which will not be subsequently heated; and**
- **Ice cubes.**

Adults, adolescents and older children may shower, bathe or wash using tap water but should avoid swallowing the water. Laundry may be washed in tap water, either by hand or by machine. Younger children and infants must be sponge bathed to ensure they do not consume water during bathing.

### ***WATER CONNECTION***

Remember to ensure that your water connection box is clearly marked and easily accessible. The valves are to remain **CLOSED** after the system is shut down each fall to prevent flooding of your cottage in the spring when the system is started up. **Important:** Any new water connections being installed on your property must be done during the off season which is typically October to April. Village water will only be turned off for emergency situations during the regular season.
